

Dear Parents and Carers

This is a rather different newsletter from our usual ones, as we let you know what we are doing behind the scenes to support you and your families whilst Playgroup is temporarily closed following Government guidelines.

We know that you will be experiencing change and upheaval in many ways. Although Playgroup is currently closed to children our senior team is working to get Playgroup ready for your children as soon as we are allowed to re-open, and is here to support you while you are at home.

June in particular wanted to send a message to all parents and carers out there to let them know that she is available Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday 9am - 3pm to talk to any parents/carers about any issue that they'd like to discuss, whether it's about the challenges of parenting during lockdown or plans for transition in September. In many cases June will be contacting you but please do feel free to pick up the phone for a chat with her. We would love just to know how you and your children are getting on.

Home learning bags

For every Playgroup child, June and her team have prepared home learning bags and will be delivering these from today onwards, observing social distancing when they drop them off. The bags will contain activities such as booklets and colouring sheets, a story book, listening garden walk sheets, craft activity, toy and diary.

Summer Term fees and funding

We would like to reassure you about fees and funding. Playgroup's committee has taken the decision not to charge parents any fees during this period of being closed. We had informed you of this previously and this remains the case. For children whose hours would have been funded we are able to continue to claim funding and we are basing your claim on the hours your child was intending to take with us this Summer Term. If you claim 30-hour funding please continue to renew your code with HMRC in the usual way. Our understanding is that you can continue to be eligible while furloughed. This all means that as and when Playgroup is able to re-open your child's place has been kept open and he/she can potentially resume sessions as normal, although this will be subject to any
