

Dear Parents and Carers

We have had a really successful first four weeks back and your children have been amazing in adapting to new routines. It has been lovely to have them back. Thank you so much to parents as well for following our guidelines - we really appreciate it. Please continue to stick rigidly to your designated arrival and collection times as this is a vital part of our policy for keeping you all safe.

We continue to work in small groups and children stay in their own 'bubble'. Children are still able to have lots of outdoor time and indoors we can tailor their 'bubble' areas to the needs of the children.

Hot weather

In the hot weather please also ensure that you send your child with their own sunhat and with an application of once a day suncream.

September onwards

We have been contacting you to ask about your plans for September so that we can plan ahead for September. If you have not yet let us know then it would be very helpful if you could let Deborah know as soon as possible so that you get the sessions you need.

Funding from September

If your child will become eligible for 15 or 30 hour funding in the Autumn Term (birthdays between 01/04/2017 and 31/08/2017) Deborah has sent out information to you and is able to guide you through the process and advise how you can use your funding.

If you claim 30-hour funding please continue to renew your code with HMRC in the usual way (unless your child is leaving for school, in which case there is no need). Our understanding is that you can continue to be eligible while furloughed.

Hand sanitiser in cars alert

Please heed advice coming out to remove bottles of alcoholbased hand sanitiser from cars in hot weather as the heat can cause flammable vapours to be released which can then ignite.

Polite request

Some residents of Bingham Road have reported to school that parents are using residents' driveways to turn their cars around. We would echo the Infant School in asking our parents to refrain from doing this as we really value our relationship with the local community. Thank you!
